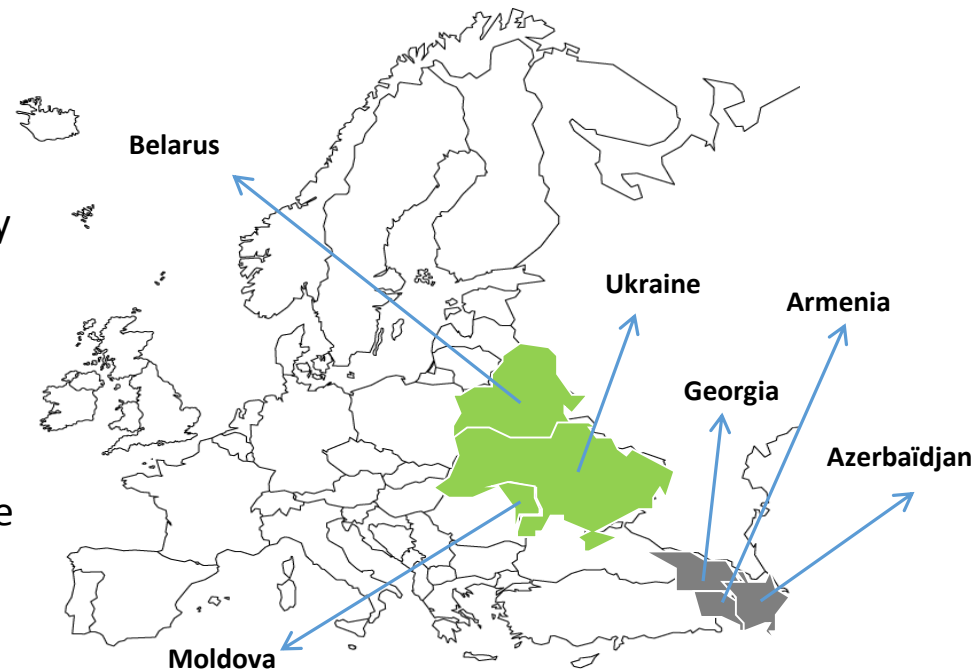
SPP is included in a component led by UNEP:

❑ Objectives

- Assist countries in the **development and implementation of SPP policies by increasing awareness and building the capacities** of policy makers and procurement managers

❑ Activities

- **Regional awareness raising and capacity building** on SPP
- Rollout of the **UNEP SPP Approach** in 3 countries (national level)

Building on a 10 Year Journey: From the MTF on SPP to the 10YFP SPP Programme

- 2005, Buenos Aires: launch of the Swiss-led MTF on SPP
- 2012, Rio: launch of the UNEP-led International SPP Initiative
- 28 March 2014: approval of the SPPI Application to become the 10YFP SPP Programme with UNEP as lead in charge of Secretariat functions and KEITI and ICLEI as co-leads



Official Launch of the 10YFP SPP Programme

The Sustainable Public Procurement Initiative (SPPI) officially became the 10YFP SPP Programme on April 1st at an event in New York, at the margins of the 10th Session of the Open Working Groups on Sustainable Development Goals

As such, the 10YFP SPP Programme officially adopted the Goals, Work Plan, Structure, MAC, and Modus Operandi of the SPPI



10YFP SPP Programme

- **Goal**

Promote worldwide implementation of SPP through **increased cooperation** between key stakeholders and a **better understanding of its potential benefits and impacts**.

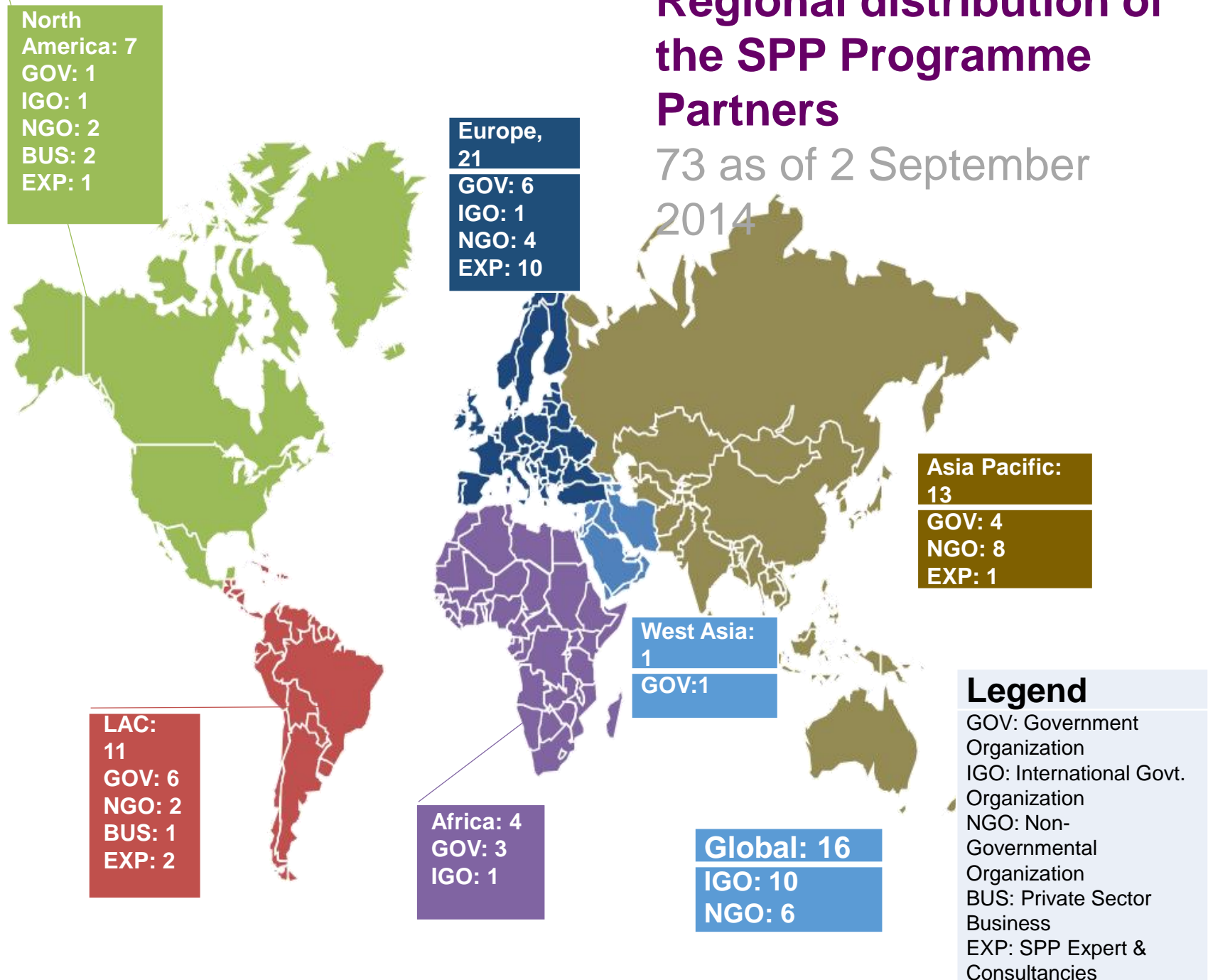
- **Objectives**

- **Build the case for SPP:** improve the knowledge on SPP and its **effectiveness** as a tool to promote greener economies and sustainable development;
- Support **the implementation of SPP on the ground** through increased collaboration and improved coordination between SPP stakeholders.

Core Activities

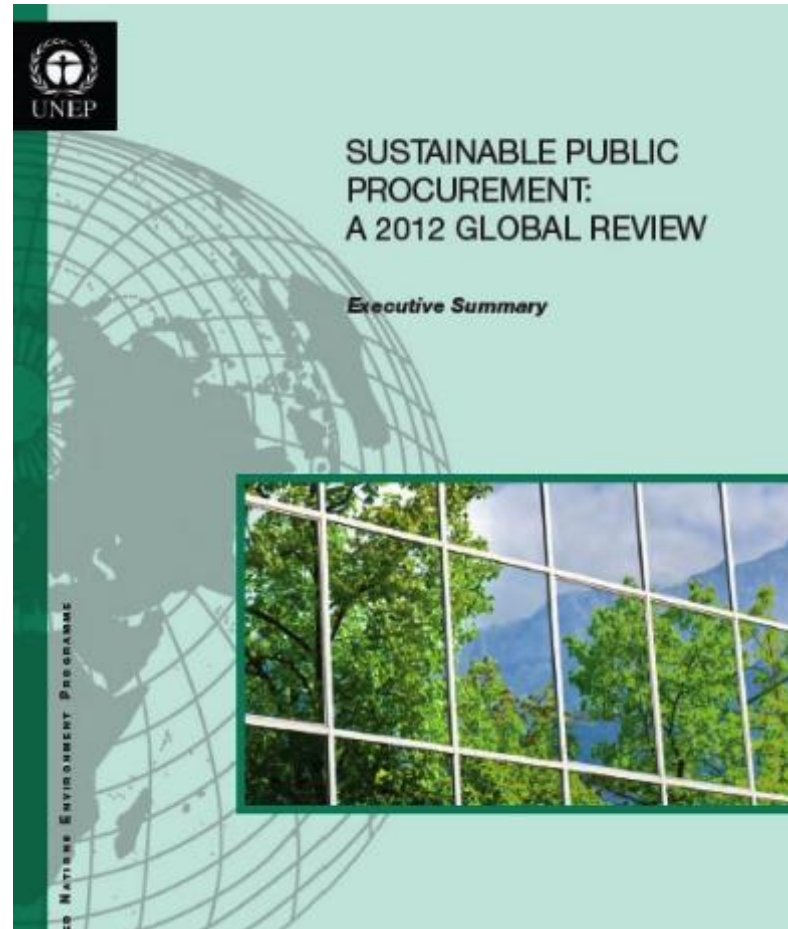
- An **SPP Community** is established on the **Global SCP Clearinghouse**
- A **Biennial report** reviews the implementation of Sustainable and Green Public Procurement

- A global survey with 273 responses

Updates on the Working Groups

- **Coordination of SPP Implementation**

- Bi-monthly Informative Webinar Series: presentations by IISD on 25 April, CEGESTI on June 30th, and Indian Railways on September 10th
- Collecting and uploading SPP resources on the SCP Clearinghouse

- **2A, Monitoring & Evaluating SPP Implementation**

- Developed mapping of different SPP monitoring and evaluation systems
- Currently reviewing and finalizing the case studies: Japan, Thailand, India, Estonia, Switzerland, Ottawa, and South Australia
- Just released first draft of recommendations – available here!

- **2B, Measuring & Communicating Impacts of SPP**

- Preliminary work and research has begun. A baseline analysis will be carried out soon, with an in-person meeting of experts at the EPA in November 2014 to discuss findings of baseline analysis



Updates on the Working Groups (cont.)

- 3A, Product-Service Systems
 - Draft of the white paper on PSS available for comments!
 - Tentatively planned to be published in one month, after further revision
- 4A, Greening supply chains
 - Pre-study on “Sustainability in Supply Chains and SPP” published on 30 June 2014 and available here!
 - Currently exploring ways to continue the work of this group
- 4B, SPP through ecolabels and standards
 - Successful in-person meeting just held in Beijing on September 22nd
 - Symposium: Bringing Sustainability with Better Labels and Better Procurement
